Dialogue



- Dialogic approaches suggest something more open
- Transparency
- Connection and belonging (to what? And why?)
- Multi-directional communication
- Space for sharing and exploration knowledge and capacity building









Looking at the principle of **dialogue**...

How would you like staff to engage you in wellbeing and belonging activities?







- Dialogue builds the relationship, trust underpins it.
- Necessary for sustainability.
- Room for competing goals to support cooperation and consensus.
- Clear rationale fairness
- Empathy







Looking at the principle of **building trust**...

How can staff earn your trust in wellbeing and belonging activity?



Equity and Inclusivity

- Diversity of people is different from diversity of approaches
- Universal and specific
- Lived experiences, visibility, and acceptance (tokenism)
- Accessible engagement

Empowerment

- Individual and collective
- Students and staff
- Crucially, addresses the role of power dynamics
- The ability to influence and inform
- Develop self-efficacy, leadership, and to disagree well
